

## National ANNEX: Austria – FWF

Apart from the rules and procedures defined in the Call Notice scientists seeking FWF funding need to consider the following points: General FWF rules and conditions apply as defined in the following documents “Funding Guidelines” and “Application Guidelines”– Version April 2016

Please keep in mind that simultaneously to the application to the ERA-CAPS-Call the Austrian partner has to send in FWF forms with stamps and signatures, itemization of requested funding, abstracts in German and English. Requested Funding should only contain FWF eligible costs (**no overheads**).

Applicants must ensure that for the project parts to be funded by the FWF all relevant points of the above mentioned “Guidelines” have been fully covered in their proposal.

Applicants must guarantee that information, resources and results obtained in FWF projects are made publicly available within a reasonable period of time and that this is not in conflict with obligations of the Principle Investigator in other projects.

The FWF cannot fund research of private industry. While companies can generally be involved as partners in FWF funded projects, necessary regulations concerning Intellectual Property Rights have to be worked out for the specific requirements of the international consortia in the framework of this ERA-Net.
